EX DRUG USERS SEXUAL BEHAVIOR IN PONTIANAK

Drug abuse has become a national problem in every country. One of the effects of drug abuse is the transmission of HIV / AIDS cases. Besides, unsafe sexual behavior takes place uncontrollably. People with this behavior are likely to have multiple partners, as well as inconsistent condom use. This study aimed at finding out the description and detail information about the sexual activities among ex drug users in Kota Pontianak. Qualitative descriptive method and phenomenology approach were carried out in this study.

The results showed that most informants had been involved in sexual activity such as caressing, kissing, fingering, role play, oral sex, intercourse, and sex parties. They also didn't have long lasting partners and didn't consistently use condoms. They considered that condoms ruined their sexual comfort even though they knew the benefits and the proper condom use. To increase their sex drive, the informants took in ex, methamphetamine, alcohol, and marijuana. Most informants were Heterosexual sex-oriented types. However, one of them had pedophilia sexual fantasy. Their gender expression was masculine.

From the findings, the informant are encouraged to control their unsafe sexual behavior. Besides, the local NGO of *Pontianak Plus* needs to provide sexual education and asks the public to participate on the dangers and the prevention of drugs.
